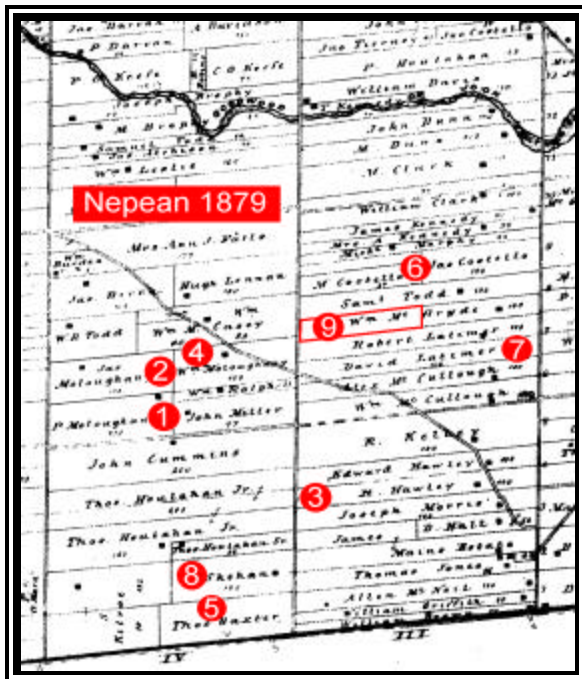


Michael (Mick) Moloughney

1.9. MICHAEL (MICK) MOLOUGHNEY (1855 - 1925)

Fourth son (ninth child) of Michael Moloughney and Ellen Murphy. Born Mar 31, 1855; baptized in St. Patrick's Church, Fallowfield, sponsored in baptism by Lewis Dempsey and Eliza Comerford. Raised on the family homestead - east half of Lot #7, Concession #4, Nepean Township, Carleton County, Ontario.

Michael was 20 years of age when his father died in 1875. He was one of three boys still on the farm - his brother Bill was 35, and Dan 18. Under the terms of the will, Michael was bequeathed \$500 and this he subsequently used to purchase the farm across the road, - on Dec 31, 1881, he bought the south half of Lot #7, Concession #3 (100 acres) from David Latimer (Shown on the attached map as #7), and this became his home farm.

On June 19, 1883, he married Ann Tierney - when he was 28 and she 20. Ann Tierney (May 13, 1863 - July 1, 1958, age 95) was the daughter of Martin Tierney and Catherine (Anne) Dunn, who farmed in Twin Elm a few miles away.

Michael and Ann had eight children during the years 1884 to 1904, on the south half of Lot #7, Concession #3. Next door to them, on the north half of Lot #7, Concession #3, were his sister Anne with her husband Martin Howe and their nine children born during 1889 - 1902. Martin died in 1904, at the young age of 45, and Michael purchased the land from the family. This land he subsequently sold to his son Paddy on Mar 22, 1912 for the sum of \$1200. Paddy did not work the land and

shortly thereafter moved into Ottawa where he established a Moving and Cartage business. The land became the property of another son, Willie, and was added to the home farm area. Willie went on to acquire additional adjoining property (i.e. 200 acres of Lot #6 Concession #3). The original farm started by Michael Moloughney exceeds 400 acres in size, and is now farmed by his grandson Leo, the third generation of the family to occupy the land.

The local schoolhouse, SS#9, was located next door on Lot #6, Concession #3 and successive teachers lived with Michael and Anne during the school season. The building had been first built as a one-room log schoolhouse in 1844, rebuilt in 1854, converted to a frame one-room building in the 1870's, and finally in the 1950's the building was sold and re-located to Manotick after it no longer was used as a schoolhouse.

Michael and Anne moved into Ottawa in 1924. Michael was now approaching his 70th year, and after a short illness he passed away on Mar 24, 1925. In a letter dated Mar 25, 1930 Anne wrote the following to a niece in Tacoma, Washington - "I have eight of a family, all grown up. Mary, the oldest, is a nun, Sister Mary Oswald, now in Brockville, Ontario. She is also a graduate nurse, being in charge of the operating room in the hospital in Brockville. She was in Alberta and Saskatchewan for several years. Patrick, the second oldest, is married here in Ottawa, having a good business. He has two little girls. Nellie comes next. Her name is Mrs. Roche, and she lives in Montreal. She had two boys and three girls. The boys are expert hockey players, and are now playing off for the Allan Cup, the hockey championship of Canada, in Toronto, Ontario. Lizzie comes next; she is married here in Ottawa (Mrs. Doyle), and has a boy and a girl. Michael is next, and he lives with me along with Lillian. They both work in the Government here. Willie is married on our old home and has two children, while the youngest of the family, Kathleen, is a nurse. She has been in Brooklyn, N.Y. for a couple of years, but is now home for a holiday."

Michael Moloughney died on Mar 24, 1925 in his 70th year and Anne, 33 years later, on July 1, 1958 in her 96th year. Both are buried in Ottawa. Their family lived to an average age of 77, with Lillian almost reaching 97. The children were baptized in St. Patrick's Church, Fallowfield.

1.9.1 Mary-Ann Moloughney - born Apr 22, 1884, sponsored by Anne Moloughney an aunt. Became a nun - Sister Mary Oswald. Died Feb 24, 1969, in her 84th year, in Kingston, Ontario.

1.9.2 Patrick Moloughney - born Feb 8, 1886, sponsored by Michael (Pat's Mick) Moloughney a cousin. Married Mrs. Alice (McElroy) Sheehan (1891 - Feb 25, 1959); owned and operated a Moving and Cartage business on Gloucester Street in Ottawa for many years. Died May 12, 1967 age 81; buried in Notre Dame Cemetery, Ottawa, Ontario. They had one stepchild and four natural children.

Married John Roche (born 1890 in Chicago, Ill. - died June 1970); he was a Baggage Master with the CPR and the couple moved to Montreal; died Apr 6, 1951, age 61; They had five children.
